Hairstylists, manicurists, and masseurs

If you have a regular **hairedresser**, consider tipping her between \$20 and \$100, depending on how often you see her and what services she performs, says Masini. "Someone who encourages you to come in for a free trim if your cut doesn't grow in the way you like, or does little things for you at no charge during the year, like adding extra conditioning treatments at no charge, or giving you a free pass for canceling at the last minute — should get more," she adds. Masini says that if your **hairstylist's assistant** also regularly helps you, you may want to get her something small as well, like a candle, jam or \$10 to \$20. The regular **manicurist** should get about \$10 to \$50 or the cost of one session plus a small gift, and the **massage therapist** should get between \$50 and \$100 or the cost of one session, says Hoffman.
