Moms from school

Sure, but not the whole class. If you're getting to know a few of the ladies, it's fine to friend them, but you won't be besties with everyone. Just be sure to keep your messages social or about school biz only (skip posts about work). Pestering people with real estate ventures or the Pilates classes you teach is a turn off.

An ex-boyfriend

Do you really care that he's a VP in sales and marketing in Akron? Or are you cyber spying to see what his kids look like and whether his wife is overweight? "Do not friend this guy! In fact, un-friend him when you break-up and leave it this way," urges Masini. You'll end up stalking him and competing without even realizing it if he's your friend on Facebook.

Your boss

Keep the bulk of your contact with your boss in the office—and out of your social life. "This relationship should be sacred, so don't friend your boss," says Masini. You don't want this person to catch a glimpse of anything you or your friends post that could be even remotely lurid or inappropriate.
